Reverend Dr. Richard Franklin Norris, Presiding Prelate of the Seventh Episcopal District of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, Dr. Novell Goff, Presiding Elder of the Edisto District of the South Carolina Annual Conference and Interim Pastor of "Mother Emmanuel African Methodist Episcopal Church, and the Seventh Episcopal District of the African Methodist

Episcopal Church are asking to be heard at _____ o'clock _____ a.m., on the _____ day of _____ at the Charleston County Courthouse, 100 Broad Street, Charleston, South Carolina before the Presiding Judge of the Circuit Court of the Ninth Judicial Circuit, appointed to hear this matter, for temporary relief pending adjudication in this case. The following temporary relief is sought:

1. Granting an extension of the "Sua Sponte Order Implementing A Temporary Protection Order" issued by The Honorable Judge J. C. Nicholson on July 16, 2015;
2. An order restraining and prohibiting all potential trial participants in these proceedings from divulging any prejudicial trial matter, evidence, or making any extrajudicial statements that has a substantial likelihood of materially prejudicing any adjudicative proceedings in the above captioned matter and to include the following:
 - a. any recordings of the 911 calls;
 - b. any and all reports of the medical examiner;
 - c. any and all reports of the coroner;
 - d. any and all reports or forensic examinations;
 - e. any and all pathology reports;
 - f. any and all investigative reports
 - g. any and all statements of witnesses
 - h. any and all information pertaining to Defendant's medical and/or mental health records and evaluations
 - i. any and all photographs, illustrations, or graphic depictions of the crime scene or victims' bodies
 - j. any and all evidence and information not specifically named but may be prejudicial to the victims, their families and the interests of justice.
3. For such other relief as this Court deems just and proper.
