


not to file a motion, then the temporary protection order would automatically expire. If the parties filed a motion, the Order would stay in place until this Court had the opportunity to convene a hearing to examine the material with the interested parties. It has come to this Court's attention that certain victims, through their respective counsel, have filed motions to hold the release of these materials.

Therefore, pursuant to this Court's prior order, the material at issue shall be held by the authorities referenced above and shall not be released to the public until the parties have had an opportunity to be heard and a hearing shall be set.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
